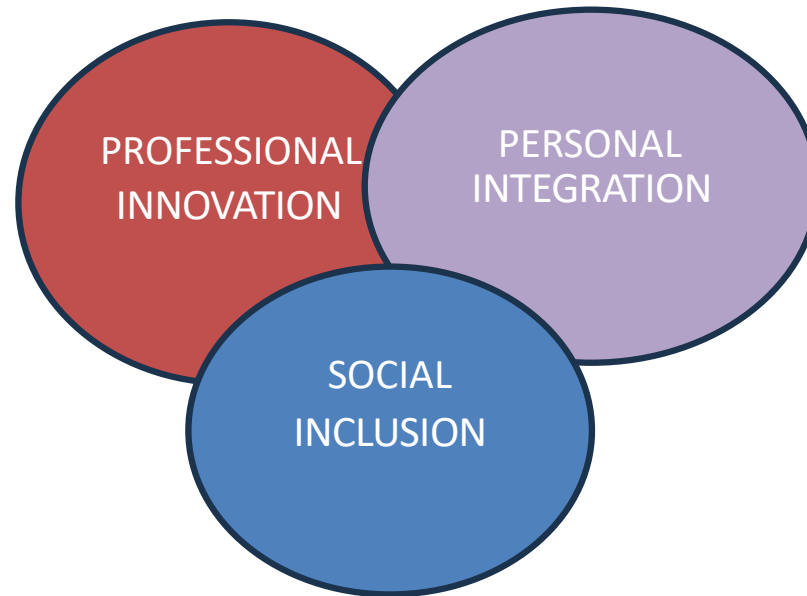

5.6 Attendance



The College expects 100% attendance at all lectures/practical per chosen course.



For legitimate reasons, a minimum of 75% attendance per course is made mandatory. Parents can check attendance on the ERP (defaulters list is put up every month) and the academic performance of their child.

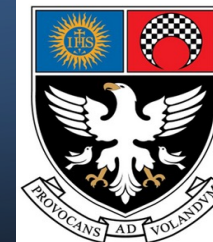


Leave application to be submitted on our website portal within 7 days with all relevant documents (X-ray, blood report, etc) doctor's certificate and a covering letter by the parent.



A student with less than 75% attendance in a course will not be allowed (terms not granted – TNG) to appear for the end semester examinations (ESE) in that course.

TY → HY (where offered)	132 credits (Sem I–VI)	0 credits	132 credits	All credits must be cleared; CGPA ≥ 7.5

Additional Examinations for TNG and ATKT students

1. **TNG (Term Not Granted) Students** – Students with attendance below 75% in a course.
2. **ATKT (Allowed to Keep Terms) Students** – Students who have failed a course by scoring:
 - Less than 40 marks in a 100-mark course, or
 - Less than 20 marks in a 50-mark course.

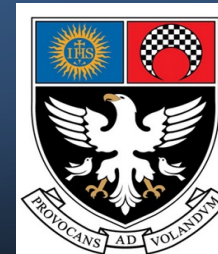
- Additional Examinations for **Odd Semester** courses (for both TNG and ATKT students) will be conducted during the **Even Semester** of the same academic year.

17.2 Zero-tolerance policy

17.3 I-Card policy

Students must always wear their college-issued I-Card on campus; failure to do so will incur a ₹200 fine, and misuse such as sharing or using friend's I-card will lead to suspension.

In case of loss, a police certificate is required to obtain a temporary or duplicate I-Card, with applicable charges contributing to the Students' Beneficiary Fund.

17.4 Decorum on campus



Avoid noise in corridors during ongoing lectures

Keep classrooms clean

Keep washrooms clean

Follow green practices, such as switching off lights and fans when not in use.

Cleanliness in the canteen is the students' responsibility, including proper disposal of used items and avoiding food waste.

Eating and drinking are allowed only in designated areas to maintain cleanliness and prevent pest infestations.

17.4, 17.6 Decorum on campus

- The gym must be used responsibly during notified hours; food is not permitted, and students are encouraged to engage in sports.
- Common rooms must be kept clean, and lockers must be hired officially and used with care.
- Use of cell phones during lectures and practical is strictly prohibited unless explicitly permitted by the lecturer, and violations may lead to confiscation of your I-card, fine of ₹500, or further disciplinary action.

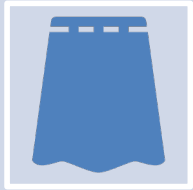
17.8 Safety
