

Commencement Ceremony - April 2027

This is to inform all eligible students of the Batch of 2027 that the College will be organising the Commencement Ceremony after the completion of the prescribed academic requirements.

I. Eligibility Guidelines

The College proposes to organise the **Commencement Ceremony for the Batch of 2027** towards the end of the Academic Year 2026–27. The ceremony is intended for students completing their respective programmes or exercising an approved exit option during the academic year.

II. Eligibility to Participate

Students shall be eligible to register for the Commencement Ceremony subject to the following academic requirements:

1. Three-Year Undergraduate Programmes –National Credit Framework (NCrF) Level 5.5

Students must have successfully completed all prescribed courses and earned the required credits up to Semester V, with no pending ATKT/backlog. Students may avail of the October 2026 ATKT examination to clear any pending courses and fulfil the eligibility requirement.

2. Postgraduate Part I Students opting for Exit – NCrF Level 6.0

Students enrolled in the First Year of a Postgraduate Programme who formally opt for the **approved exit qualification at NCrF Level 6.0** must have successfully completed all prescribed courses and earned the required credits **up to Semester I, with no pending ATKT/backlog**.

3. Two-Year Postgraduate Programmes – NCrF Level 6.5

Students completing a Two-Year Postgraduate Programme must have successfully completed all prescribed courses and earned the required credits up to Semester III, with no pending ATKT/backlog from Semesters I to III.

III. Clearance of Backlogs / ATKT/TNG:

Students with backlogs in any of the semesters specified above are advised to avail themselves of the October 2026 ATKT examination and clear all pending courses (Including ECC, CEP/SIP, etc.). Eligibility for the Commencement Ceremony will be determined based on successful completion of the prescribed courses and required credits after the declaration of the October 2026 ATKT results.

IV. Terms Not Granted (TNG):

Students who are awarded Terms Not Granted (TNG) in the final semester of the respective NCrF levels shall not be eligible to participate in the Commencement Ceremony.

V. Disciplinary Matters:

Students involved in major disciplinary matters may be restricted from participation. The final decision in such cases shall rest with the Principal.

Only students satisfying the applicable eligibility requirements shall be permitted to register for the Commencement Ceremony. Details regarding the **date(s), registration process and schedule** will be communicated separately.
