



**ANNOUNCEMENT OF KHALID AND ZEYNA ANSARI FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS  
FOR ELIGIBLE STUDENTS IN MASS COMMUNICATION AND JOURNALISM  
DEPARTMENT, ST. XAVIER'S COLLEGE, MUMBAI- 400001**

**FOR THE YEAR COMMENCING JUNE 2026**

**The following are the details and process to apply for this scholarship.**

1. These scholarships are available for the media courses listed under point 3A below.
2. The student should have cleared the mandatory entrance tests, as conducted by the St. Xavier's College for these courses and should have secured a seat and completed admission formalities to join in the specified courses for the academic year commencing June 2026.
3. The details of the courses for which Scholarships are offered are as follows:
  - A. Degree program, BA(MCJ) by the Mass Media Department 'The Khalid & Zeyna Ansari Foundation Scholarship' for the three-year course, BA degree in Mass Communication & Journalism (BA MCJ).
4. The Foundation will directly pay the 50% scholarship to the selected students. The remaining 50% will be paid by the student to the college.
5. Orphans and students with severe financial need may be considered for a full Scholarship from the Foundation after their applications are scrutinised.
6. Proof of financial need with relevant attestation is mandatory.
7. Application for the Scholarships will be through the link attached below. Thereafter, students who wish to avail of this Scholarship must approach their respective course coordinator.
8. The application form must be accompanied with a Statement of Purpose on how the student will use this education for personal and as well benefit of the community. Please refer to the NGO Guide on the Khalid & Zeyna Ansari Foundation website, for details on its concept of 'pay it forward' for educational scholarships.
9. Preference will be given to female candidates, in keeping with the Khalid and Zeyna Ansari Foundation's objectives.
10. For the BA course, Khalid & Zeyna Ansari Foundation will reimburse to the student's family the fees paid for the student during the scholarship period, after the student has completed one year of employment, upon furnishing of proof of employment.
