1. Progressive Learning Ability Test (PLAT)

The Progressive Learning Ability Test (PLAT) will be conducted on **25th July 2026** for all undergraduate second-year (SY) and third-year (TY) students.

The test aims to evaluate students' employability skills and provide actionable insights into areas that require attention and further development. As a comprehensive, skill-based career readiness program, PLAT evaluates 12 critical skills, including Communication, Problem Solving, and Emotional Intelligence. These competencies are foundational to enhancing professional readiness and success across diverse fields. The assessment is structured to bridge the gap between academic knowledge and workplace requirements, ensuring you are thoroughly equipped to prosper whether you transition directly into the job market or pursue postgraduate studies.

2. Mandatory Participation

Attendance and completion of this test are strictly **mandatory** for the following groups:

All Undergraduate (UG) students of SY and TY classes: All SY & TY students across BA, BSc, BSc (IT), BSc (DSAI), BSc (BCB), BAF, BAMCJ, and BCom with MS.

Important Notice on Non-Compliance: Failure to attempt the test will attract a penalty fine of **Rs. 300/-**. Additionally, the non-compliant student's marksheet will be withheld until the PLAT is successfully re-attempted, either on-campus or at the designated office site of the PLAT administrator, as the situation dictates.

A) What exactly is PLAT?

PLAT stands for the Progressive Learning Ability Test. It evaluates core workplace competencies beyond traditional

academic testing, assessing 12 critical skills essential for enhancing professional employability.

B) How does PLAT benefit me?

It highlights your professional strengths and developmental areas by providing clear, practical feedback. The evaluation is customised according to your specific program to ensure metrics remain relevant to your field.

C) Can PLAT assist with career guidance?

While PLAT does not issue direct job placement suggestions, it provides indirect assistance by outlining your skill proficiency profiles. This helps you make informed choices about your future career pathways.

D) Is the test applicable to all students equally?

Yes, it is built for every student, focusing on individual capability profiles rather than purely academic scores. Tests are customised to align directly with the specific requirements of your discipline.

E) How do I prepare for PLAT?

No formal preparation or study is required. PLAT measures your baseline skill sets. Approach the test with an open mind to receive the most accurate evaluation.

F) Will the results affect my academic grades?

No. PLAT is a completely ungraded assessment designed strictly to provide developmental feedback. It will not impact your GPA or course marks.

G) How long does the test take to complete?

The test is structured to be manageable, comprehensive,

and well-contained within the allotted time blocks.
